Ordering Information

Orders may be placed Monday through Friday from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. by phone, email, or in person at Owens Food Court. Pick-up hours are daily from 10:30 A.M. to 11:30 A.M. and 2:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M.

A minimum of 72 hours notice is required for all orders.

Cookout packages can only be purchased with Flex Dollars. Payment should be made at the time of pick-up to any Owens Food Court cashier.

For group orders, each group member must be present for his or her account to be accessed, as the use of an individual's ID card by any other person is a violation of the University Policies for Student Life.

Retain your receipt until your order is in hand. Your Flex account will be charged for any orders that are not picked up.

If you are a person with a disability and desire assistance or accommodation, please contact a dining center manager.

Food Handling Instructions

Cold foods should be maintained at 40 °F or below until served.

Raw meats should be stored away from other foods to avoid cross-contamination.

A thermometer must be used to ensure the correct internal cooking temperature has been reached for hamburger patties, since consuming undercooked ground beef can cause serious illness and can be fatal. Cook burgers on both sides until juices are clear, then insert a thermometer into the center of patty and check for an internal temperature of 155 °F. When using the disposable thermometers listed on this order form, the tip of the thermometer will turn from white to black when 155 °F has been reached.

Chill uneaten burgers below 40 °F within two hours of cooking, or discard.
